up?

Dick What will she think? Do you think she'd have me as a son-in-

law?

Alice I'm sure she will. She doesn't have much choice.

Dick I know I'm poor now Alice, but one day I will be rich and famous-

you'll see.

Dick We'd best settle down here for the night anyway Alice. Tom has

work to do, and I won't leave him to do it alone. Talking of Tom,

where did he go? (Shouts Tom)

Tom enters Front left

Alice Ahh here he is. I'll leave you two to it then. Night Dick, night

Tom.
